

Hello exchange,

In my last letter I already wrote some things about school, so in this letter I'll ~~also~~ describe a day at school. My day starts at 6.30 in the morning, normally the snooze goes a few more times, so I get up at 6.45 and I'm gonna make myself ready for school. At 7.30 'o'clock I leave my house to cycle to school together with Emily, one of my best friends. Cycling to school takes 45 minutes till an hour. When we arrive at school, I put my bike in the bicycle storage, put some of my books in my locker, so my bag gets less heavy and I say hello to my friends. At 8.30 the first lesson, in this case Dutch lesson, starts. All the lessons take 50 minutes. After fifty minutes of Dutch, we have a Biology lesson, and then an hour with ~~four~~ our mentor. At 11.00 'o'clock we have the first break of the day, this lasts 20 ~~3~~ minutes (because of this we call it the small break). After this break we have a German lesson, and a Geography lesson. At 13.00 'o'clock the 'long' break starts (we call it live that because it lasts 30 minutes), this is the second and last break of the day. Then the English lesson starts, and finally we have a lesson of French. At 15.10 'o'clock school is done and Emily and I cycle home. Around 16.00 'o'clock we arrive home. When I've arrived I first take a rest of about half an hour and then I start doing my homework.

I just described a day at school on Tuesday when I've got 7 hours of lessons, but every day I have a different time table:

- Monday: the 4th until the 7th hour (11.20 till 15.10 'o'clock)
- Tuesday: 7 hours (8.30 till 15.10 'o'clock)
- Wednesday: 5 hours (8.30 till 13.00 'o'clock)
- Thursday: 7 hours (8.30 till 15.10 'o'clock)
- Friday: 5 hours (8.30 till 13.00 'o'clock)

Now I hope you've got an idea of what a day at my school looks like.
